Academically, our students are making every attempt to be their best. The *Performing Arts Academy* students are embarking on new learning ground by using their artistic talents to help them learn more in physics, advanced math, College English, and government. Seventy-percent of our graduates go on to colleges like Syracuse, Fordham, Harvard, and New Paltz, to mention a few. Students in the middle school's single-gender classes are breaking new ground. Their academic grades are better; they feel more positive about themselves, and they are paying closer attention to learning.

Our elementary students are finding their way through the maze of learning how to read and compute. Grants from the *21st Century Community*

Learning Center and the help from thirty other initiatives help us to provide more academic and co-curricular services for our students. The professional development school program, developed through a coalition with *SUNY New Paltz*, enables our staff to be connected with schools of higher learning.

Our schools are clean! Our schools are safe! Our schools are helping the children of this community to be the best that they can be! Life in the Ellenville schools is vibrant and joyful. It spans the academic, social, and athletic spheres of life.
