Shawangunk Country Club Opens to the Public

The *Shawangunk Country Club* of Ellenville is located on **Country Club Road**, just south of the Village (photo, right). Established in 1927, the nine-hole golf course expects to be open for play around April 1st. The club is known for its excellent greens and fairways, with a challenging but fair layout. With three par-3 holes, par for the course is 68, with an updated course rating of 68.0 and a slope of 129 for the men, as established by the Metropolitan Golf Association in 2002. The new ladies course rating is 69.3 and a slope of 121, with a par of 70.

Shawangunk Golf Shop is open weekdays from 7:00 AM until dark. Opening for the season is expected around April 1st with a closing date in late November. The club is open to the public for either nine or 18 holes. Carts are available for those golfers who prefer to ride. The club also has twilight rates in April after 4:00 PM.

In addition to golf, the club provides a spectacular view of the valley with exquisite scenery, particularly during fall foliage. A swimming pool, putting green, and a restaurant with a wonderful outdoor eating facility and spectacular scenery complete the available options for your enjoyment.

Introductory membership rates for 2003 are \$500 single and \$750 family. A new, corporate membership is being offered for the first time this season.

All the regular golf equipment and supplies are offered at reasonable prices through the full service pro shop. Lessons, groups of lessons, and gift certificates are additionally available for gifts.

Summer leagues have openings for interested golfers. Ladies' league is on Tuesday evenings and the men's league is held on Thursdays. Openings are available in both for singles or pairs of golfers. Golf clinics for all ages and types of golfers will be held. Look for sign-up sheets on the bulletin boards.

The club runs a number of small, intimate outings each season. If you have a group of up to 50 golfers, contact the pro shop for prices and availability.

So, if you are looking for a place to play a quick nine holes (or 18 holes), usually with no waiting, or if you are looking for a place to hold a small golf outing, or if you are looking for golf and dinner, try the *Shawangunk Country Club* in Ellenville.
