18. More information is needed to form an educated decision on dissolution of the Village. I believe it should be left up to the voters to decide, only after all the facts have been gathered.

19. Additional comments: I believe the Village of Ellenville is beginning to take a turn for the better. People are becoming more interested in the area, real estate sales appear to be on the rise, and homes are more affordable than in other areas. I believe if we continue to work with the Chamber of Commerce, Beautification Committee, other community groups, and residents who are interested in the good of the Village, we can develop a plan to make the Village more attractive. I have heard that destiny is a matter of choice or a matter of chance. Now is the time for us all to choose to take matters into our own hands or leave them to chance. Thank you.
