Robert Eggers Retrospective at Ellenville Public Library

A retrospective exhibit of the works of the late Robert (Bob) Eggers will be featured at the **Ellenville Public Library & Museum's** Gallery Link, **40 Center Street**, from **June 2nd** through **June 30th**. The artist's family – son William, and daughters Cindy, Amy, and Betsy Eggers – have coordinated the show. A reception will be held on **Thursday, June 5th**, from **6:00 to 8:00 PM** in the Gallery. The public is cordially invited to attend.



Eggers, who died in a kayaking accident one year ago, was co-owner and operator of the Company Hill Art Gallery on Abeel Street in Kingston for 15 years. He began his art career while living and working in the Ellenville area, where he was well known for his watercolors and pen & ink drawings depicting local scenery. His family recalls, "This area gave him the inspiration for many of his paintings. One gallery couldn't possibly hold all of them, but we will try to put together a show that covers everything from his early paintings, done while living in Napanoch, to his more recent works, done while living on the waterfront in Kingston."

A member of the Hudson River Watercolor Society and the Kingston Artist Group, Eggers was instrumental in opening the Company Hill Path near his Abeel Street Gallery and was well known for promoting the arts in Kingston, particularly in the Rondout.
