

Town Unveils Monument at Lippman Park

On Saturday, August 23rd, the Town of Wawarsing unveiled a monument commemorating a select number of individuals and organizations that have contributed time, effort, and additional lands to our Town Park.

On separate bronze plaques, Joseph and Lana Tso received the Town's thanks for donating two separate pieces of land to **Lippman Park**. The *Open Space Institute* was also honored in the same way for purchasing lands from the **Lundy Estate** and encouraging the Department of Environmental Conservation in donating 19 additional acres of that purchase to the Town of Wawarsing.

These recent land acquisitions have added over 70 acres for recreational development in addition to the acreage already being developed.

According to Supervisor Craft, with the new lands in place the Town can begin to think seriously about a master plan for the park. Some of the facilities that can now be considered are: adult and youth soccer fields; baseball diamonds for all ages; hiking, bicycle, and horse trails; music concerts; tent camping sites; etc.

With each new improvement to the park, more and more of our residents are enjoying its facilities. Growth and expansion in this area should continue for years to come.
