1. Social Services remains the one department that spends the highest percentage of County tax dollars, largely due to State mandates. We must continue to apply pressure to our State representatives to reduce welfare costs at the local level.

- 2. We continue to keep an eye on costs and constantly looking for new revenue streams that do not burden county taxpayers and always looking for ways to streamline county operations.
- 3. An important and perhaps one of the most important aspect of County government is the creation and maintaining of employment. Ulster County Development Corporation, (UCDC) is the lead agency and has been very active in job creation. They have identified new areas and catalog empty buildings that would be suitable for new or expanding business. In some cases they have provided a funding source for new ventures as well as expansion capitol. One such project, the recreation of the D&H Canal, in my view would be a financial bonanza for our area and produce many other businesses. It could re-establish tourism in our community as a major industry.
- 4. Ulster County budget in past years has remained close to status quo, and in some cases even reduced the tax rate.

Until fair & accurate representation is established, plain-dealing & open government won't be.

- 2. After #1 is fixed, the following can be addressed: fiscally-prudent and vigilant oversight; sensible planning & responsible, sustainable economic development; equitable pay & respect for employees, public and private; fairer distribution of town burdens regarding social and medical costs.
- 3. Ellenville, Wawarsing, and Ulster County must be analyzed for features and "benefits," and professionally "packaged," just like any product, and then vigorously promoted to prime businesses and potential development partners – online, in the media, and directly.
- 4. End "tax & spend" pork projects our kids' kids will be paying for; end gold-plated health care for part-time legislators; aggressively lobby state and federal governments to stop increasing mandates while shifting costs downward; zero-based budgeting; eliminate non-existent "positions" designed to pad budgets; consolidate offices and facilities into existing or bargain properties, and get "white elephants" back on the tax rolls.
