## Art Exhibit in Cragsmoor

The *Cragsmoor Historical Society* presents “Out from Under,” an exhibition of the works of Joan Lesikin, September 27<sup>th</sup> through October 12<sup>th</sup>. This exhibition of oil paintings and works on paper reflects the artist’s sensual, textured, and beautifully-considered subject matter.

Lesikin says of her work: “In the ‘Out from Under’ series, the subject matter is underwear – women’s panties and bras, and men’s briefs. I explore these familiar objects beyond their function as undergarments or erotic costume. I invite viewers to see underwear as other possibilities in form, scale, milieu, and intention in order to transcend familiar conceptions.” Lesikin has mastered many media and has developed a visceral, tactile, emotional yet intellectual imagery. The eye caresses the luxurious myriad of colors in the forms floating through their dreamlike landscapes.

Lesikin, a life-long Hudson Valley resident, received art training at three art institutions. At Rutgers University (now Rutgers’ Mason Gross School of the Arts), she received an MFA. At School of Art, Syracuse University, Syracuse, NY, the artist received a BFA. In addition, Lesikin studied at the Art Students League Summer School, Woodstock, NY, where she was a recipient of the Woodstock Artists Association Grant. Her work is in numerous private and corporate collections, including the former Museum of Modern Art Loan Collection in NYC, Galleria Juana Mordo in Madrid, Spain, and French & Co. Gallery in NYC.
