The situation is: we will make payroll... tomorrow. The union folks will be very happy about that. So will everybody else. We have many of our employees here. We have many people from our community here. I thank them for that. We have

some board members here. There is a great community support that has been coming out, as the community has become aware of the situation.

We'll probably make the next payroll after that. After that, it's kind of week to week. I implore you to please, each of you, to support this institution. We will not survive if we don't find a way. We're looking at many other options. Many members of the legislature have been involved in that and have been very, very helpful in identifying various other sources of funds that may help us in this bridge, as we implement our recovery plan. We have to survive long enough to get there to be able to recover. I don't have a lot to say except, really, please help us. It is a very difficult situation; this community is geographically isolated. Without the hospital, we will have the negative impact, possibly for generations, and I'd just like to thank you for this opportunity. Thank you, very much."
