2nd Bicentennial Meeting June 1st

The **Town of Wawarsing Bicentennial Committee** has scheduled its second public planning session for **Tuesday, June 1**, at the **Community Room** of the **Ellenville Public Library & Museum**. The first planning session was well received by a varied group of 38 local citizens representing more than two dozen organizations. A long list of suggestions was drafted, and the participants were urged to share their enthusiasm with friends and neighbors (see our April issue, #17, page 6 for details).


Since that meeting, the **Bicentennial Committee** has continued to discuss the community input and has begun to create the 2006 celebration calendar. **March 14th, 2006**, is the date of the official anniversary, two hundred years from the passage of the special act of the New York State Legislature cutting off a portion of the Town of Rochester to create a "separate Town by the name of Wawarsing."

The 225th anniversary of the burning of Wawarsing (the hamlet) will be commemorated on August 12th by an encampment of Pawling's Levies in Wawarsing. On Sunday morning, August 12, 1781, about 300 Indians and Tories descended on the little settlement at Wawarsing. Colonel Albert Pawling and some of his men moved from Marbletown to Wawarsing to see if they could help. According to Colonel Pawling's report, about thirty structures were burned, one man was killed and scalped, and various horses and other livestock were stolen.

Plans for an all-class reunion of **Ellenville Alumni** has already been scheduled for August 26th, the same day as the **Chamber of Commerce's** annual street fair and festival.

The **Committee** has chosen Saturday, October 14th, 2006, for the Bicentennial closing event.

The focus of the June 1st planning meeting will be the building of the Bicentennial calendar. Community participants are invited to add to the base calendar events sponsored by their organizations, everything from the annual strawberry festivals, dinners, penny socials, and regular events to separate and special celebrations commemorating the historical anniversary.

Public planning session #2 is open to all, both those at the first meeting and other local citizens who want to be involved. The meeting will begin at **7:00 PM** and should last about an hour. Refreshments will be available, as will more canvas Bicentennial bags.
