

## Bicentennial Ornaments on Sale

The fifth and sixth Bicentennial ornaments will go on sale at the **Ellenville Public Library & Museum** on Saturday, **July 10<sup>th</sup>**, from **12 noon to 2 PM**. They represent the *Ellenville Reformed Church* and the *Federated Church of Kerhonkson*, each accompanied by a brief history.


Ornaments will also be available at each of the July Saturday evening concerts in **Liberty Square**, which begin July 10<sup>th</sup>. *Napanoch Reformed Church*, *Cragmoor Stone Church*, and *Shiloh Baptist Church* ornaments are still available; *St. Mary's Church* is sold out at this time.

At the same time, the **Bicentennial Committee** will offer a special "Pay In Advance" opportunity for those collectors who are interested in a guarantee that they will secure future ornaments in their desired colors. The "Pay in Advance" price for one each of the twelve remaining ornaments in the scheduled set of sixteen will be \$108.

Four ornaments will be released in each of 2004 (two in the spring and two in the fall), 2005, and 2006. The **Bicentennial Committee** will set aside the prepaid ornaments before the open sale begins, thus assuring the purchaser that the desired ornament has been secured, whether the purchaser could be one of the early customers, or not.

The reservation form will include three prioritized choices of color, since not all ornaments will necessarily be available in every color. Reservations for ornaments will be accepted only as part of the advance payment plan. Forms will be available on July 10<sup>th</sup>.

The Bicentennial ornaments are part of the **Town of Wawarsing Bicentennial Committee's** long-term fundraising for the events planned for 2006, the 200<sup>th</sup> birthday of the township. Celebratory activities will begin March 14, 2006, and conclude October 14, 2006.

All organizations in the Town of Wawarsing are invited to schedule their 2006 events as Bicentennial celebrations, which will be listed on a special Bicentennial calendar, already in the planning stage. The next public planning session is planned for late September/early October and all community residents and groups are invited to attend. It will be listed in the calendar of the September issue of *Wawarsing.Net*.
