

English Award – Jennifer Matthews

A medal given by the Ellenville High School to the senior who has the highest average in English for three and one-half years in high school.

Eugene and Pearl Glusker Memorial Award – Deborah Julian

Awarded to a senior who will be pursuing an education in the field of law, public service or business and who has devoted time to school and community service.

Foreign Language Award – Frankie Brown

An award to a senior who has shown all-around excellence in foreign language study.

Friends of David Sinick – Edward Wendel

This award, in memory of David H. Sinick, a 1969 graduate of Ellenville High School, awarded to a deserving graduating senior who will be furthering his education in the field of medicine or medical research.

Gail Doolittle Memorial Award – Sarah Coopersmith

An award in memory of Gail Doolittle to a student who is pursuing a career in business.

General George Armstrong Custer Award – Hunter Tsoucalas

An award given to the graduating student who has shown "Courage Under Fire" despite the odds against him.
