## CompPlan Meeting Dates Set for August Throughout Wawarsing

As you may already know, the Town of Wawarsing is beginning the process of updating its Comprehensive Plan. The Town Board has secured the services of Fairweather Consulting and the Shepstone Management Company to assist the Town in this effect. During the planning process, we have had two meetings with members of the Town and Village Boards, Town and Village Planning and Zoning Boards, and key community leaders to review the Plan and make suggestions for the Plan's direction.

The Town Board invites all residents to attend these public meetings to help shape the updated Comprehensive Plan for the Town of Wawarsing. We are holding our first public meeting about the Plan on **Monday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>** from **7:00 PM to 9:00 PM** at the **Shawangunk Senior Center** in Napanoch. The purpose of this meeting is to brief the public on the Comprehensive Plan process, answer any questions someone may have, and to get the public's ideas regarding the issues to be addressed by the Comprehensive Plan.


The Town will hold three to four similar meetings over the next few months. The next one is scheduled for **Wednesday, August 18<sup>th</sup>** in Kerhonkson, at the **Kerhonkson Fire House**. A third is tentatively scheduled for **Wednesday, August 25<sup>th</sup>** in Greenfield Park, at the **Fire Station** next to the Greenfield Post Office. We hope all residents will take this opportunity to participate in the Comprehensive Plan.

For official purposes, a Comprehensive Plan is intended to set the overall direction for growth and development in the Town. Once adopted, the Comprehensive Plan becomes the legal basis by which the Town creates or amends its zoning ordinance. At the same time, the Comprehensive Plan is an opportunity for the entire community of Wawarsing to reflect on the opportunities and problems facing the Town and to come together to establish a set of policy recommendations to respond to these circumstances.

A Comprehensive Plan can be used to answer a variety of questions about Wawarsing. They can include:

- What should Wawarsing look like in the future?
- Where should there be open space?
- Where should there be housing?
- Where should there be businesses?
- What do we need to protect?
- What should we try to improve?

The Comprehensive Plan can be an opportunity for the entire community to engage in a discussion of our future directions. The Town Board hopes the residents of Wawarsing will be able to attend these meetings. If you have any questions about this, feel free to contact the Supervisor's Office at **647-6570 ext. 6**.
