### Katharine T. Terwilliger Lecture:

*The Minisink Trail*

**Wednesday, August 18<sup>th</sup>, 7 PM**

Dr. Evan Pritchard, Author of "Native New Yorkers" published by Council Oak Books, will present a slide show and lecture on the history of the **Minisink Trail**. Familiarly known as **Route 209**, the Trail starts at the Rondout in Kingston and follows through Hurley and heads south through Ellenville and on to Port Jervis. Dr. Pritchard's discussion will focus on the New York State section of the Trail.

The talk will deal with the Orient Point Culture of 11,000 BCE and fast forward to more current times.

Dr. Pritchard is a Professor of Native American History at Marist College, where he teaches World Views and Values. He is also Director of the Center for Algonquin Culture in Woodstock, New York.
