


has taken on new life with a host of improvements, including the purchase of additional lands, new equipment and services, and a full-time employee. Supervisor Dolaway has also indicated that the town is working with the FAA in the attempt to open up some of the available airport land for industrial expansion.

In further news, Senator Charles Schumer announced the Airport will receive almost \$650,000 in federal funds for two purposes: the Federal Aviation Administration will grant the **Joseph Y. Resnick Airport** \$225,000 to build a snow removal equipment building, and it will also receive \$344,000 to construct a taxiway.


Finally, a sumptuous 4-page color brochure touting the **Resnick Airport** has been printed by the NYS Dept. of Transportation; copies are available at **Town Hall**. 

Ulster Heights Residents Plan for Bicentennial

Ulster Heights residents were invited to a meeting at the **Ulster Heights Methodist Church** on August 13th, to discuss possibilities for the celebration of the **Town of Wawarsing Bicentennial** in 2006.

Representatives from the **Methodist Church, Ulster Heights Rod and Gun Club**, the Town Board, the **Town Bicentennial Committee**, and other interested residents met for about an hour and a half to review such activities as a church social, a square dance, republication of the Ulster Heights history published by Al Carlson about 1976, and utilization of the **District 30 Schoolhouse**, which is currently in the process of restoration.

No firm decisions were made, since the appropriate organizations need to have their memberships involved in the process, but positive suggestions (and memories) were thoroughly discussed.
