## Code Enforcement Specialist Sought

The Village of Ellenville, in an effort to fulfill a Community Projects Appropriation Agreement (#M030627) with the State of New York Department of State, will be designating a Temporary Code Implementation Specialist to work under the direction of the Municipal Code Enforcement Officer.

The strategy of this appropriation is to assist the current Building Inspector with notice of violations, real estate file research, fire code inspections and various other quality of life issues such as trash and litter, junk vehicles, and property maintenance code violations.

The offer will be in place for nine months, beginning on October 27, 2004 and will terminate on July 31, 2005. The amount allocated to this project will be \$550 per week, with a time commitment of 37.5 hours per week.

Interested parties should have an understanding of, or a background in, municipal building codes, New York State Fire Codes, and be familiar with the Village of Ellenville. ### Center Street and Areas South of Center Street

### Areas North of Center Street

Monday Oct. 25<sup>th</sup> through Friday Oct. 29<sup>th</sup>

Residents are requested not to use bags. Items that will be picked up are leaves, yard waste, free limbs, and brush. Tree limbs and brush must be in lengths no larger than four-feet, tied in bundles, and in separate piles, or they will not be picked up.


Absolutely no car parts, building materials, paint cans, roofing materials, stones, rocks, drums of any size, tires, appliances, or the like will be picked up.

## Village Hears Resident Concerns

At the Village Board Walk of September 13<sup>th</sup>, Village officials met with **Ellenridge** residents and project developers (*photo, above*) to review the erosion damage done by recent torrential rains (a 25-year and 50-year storm within one month). Residents had an opportunity to express various concerns including erosion repair and run-off control, and the side-effects of ongoing construction above existing homes. Village engineers were asked to review previous plans and specifications in light of these concerns and report their findings to the Board.

The Village is also beginning major repair work in the **Penny Place** area, also hard hit by run-off over time. This, too, was the result of an earlier Village Board walk, where officials got to see conditions first hand and hear from residents.
