Schrade Cutlery designed and donated memorial knives for distribution to the ninety living *Clayton's Memorial Band* members.

Town Historian Katharine T. Terwilliger, in addition to unlimited assistance with documentation of historical facts and the publication of a memorial history of *Clayton's Band*, funded luncheon for returning *Band* members at the *Library*.

Beginning at noon on July 6, 1985, a wonderfully emotional luncheon, reunion, and opening of the *Band* exhibit flowed seamlessly. Unfortunately, so did the rain that began to come down in buckets during the luncheon, effectively killing the plan to have an outdoor concert.

At 4 PM on Saturday, July 6, 1985, *Clayton's Memorial Band*, led by George Wolf, former Drum Major of *Clayton's Military Band*, filed into the main adult area of the *Library* to perform in concert (*photo above, Bruce Belanger upper right*). Twenty-seven veteran *Band* members were part of the *Memorial Band*.

The program included the National Anthem and four marches, as well as comments by *Library* Board President Patricia Clinton, Miss Terwilliger, and for the *Band*, George Wolf.

The program concluded with the audience of about 300 singing "Auld Lang Syne" as the *Band* played... and not a dry eye in the house!
