Library Hosts Holiday Programs

The *Ellenville Public Library & Museum's Terwilliger House Museum*, an 1895 Queen Anne Victorian home, is the setting for the *Shawangunk Garden Club's Annual Holiday Tea*, **Saturday, December 4th** from **1:00 to 3:00 PM**. This year's theme is "A Winter Wedding." The highlights of the event include the formal tea service with homemade cookies, in addition to the thematic decorations hand crafted by the *Garden Club* members. The *Ellenville High School Chamber Singers*, directed by Robert Oheme, will provide holiday music for the event.

The *Library's Annual International Holiday Party* is scheduled for **Sunday, December 5th**, from **3:00 to 5:00 PM** in the **Community Room**. The event features a desert buffet by students in the *Library's* literacy program. This year's special feature is a visit by Mr. and Mrs. Santa Claus (a.k.a. Doris and Ed Lamon of Kerhonkson) as well as gifts provided by the Village of Ellenville. The *Library's* knitting group will sponsor a mitten tree.

The December art exhibit in the **Gallery Link** will feature a retrospective exhibit of paintings by the late Joan Lowe, who was a *Shawangunk Garden Club* member for many years. Joan's sister Pat Foster is coordinating the exhibit with Diane DeChillo, the *Library's* Community Relations Liaison.

Children's Librarian Susan Mangan will host a *Holiday Story Time* for preschool children ages 3-5 on **Thursday, December 9th** at **10:30 AM and 1:00 PM**. *Toddler Story Time* for ages 18 months to 3 years is scheduled for **Tuesdays, December 7th** and **December 14th** at **10:30 AM**. She will offer a *Holiday Craft-a-Thon* for ages 7 and older on **Thursday, December 2nd** from **4:00 to 6:00 PM**. These activities will take place in the **Community Room, 40 Center Street**. Registration is required for the children's programs and can be arranged by calling the main desk at **647-5530**.


The public is also cordially invited to join the *Library's* ongoing weekly activities including the **Tuesday** night Scrabble game from **6:00 to 8:00 PM**; **Saturday** morning knitting group (The Nimble Knitters) at **10:00 AM**, and a weekly movie on **Wednesdays** at **4:00 PM**.
