Over the last weekend in February, I learned first hand why supporting the *Ellenville First Aid and Rescue Squad* and *Ellenville Regional Hospital* is far more than a financial debate for the residents of the Ellenville area.

On Friday evening, my mother required immediate medical attention and, within minutes of a call to 911, an ambulance was at the door to my parent's house and, following a short family debate as to whether she should be transported to Horton Hospital or *Ellenville Regional Hospital*, she was transported to *Ellenville Regional Hospital*.

Far from a backwards rural hospital or a facility working with a weekend skeleton crew, my mother received care and attention including examination from the emergency room doctor, an internist, a cardiologist, and a neurologist. The nature of the examination and the tests my mother received would rival any urban hospital during regular weekday business hours. The very fact that this all took place over a weekend makes it all the more incredible.

I urge all residents of the Village of Ellenville, the Town of Wawarsing, and surrounding areas to support the *Ellenville Regional Hospital* and *Ellenville First Aid and Rescue Squad* so it will be there for you and your loved ones in times of crisis when immediate medical attention is required.

Center Street and Areas South of Center Street
Monday April 23rd through Friday April 29th
Monday May 9th through Friday May 13th

Areas North of Center Street
Monday May 2nd through Friday May 6th
Monday May 16th through Friday May 20th

Residents are requested not to use bags. Items that will be picked up are leaves, yard waste, free limbs, and brush. Tree limbs and brush must be in lengths no larger than four-feet, tied in bundles, and in separate piles, or they will not be picked up. Absolutely no car parts, building materials, paint cans, roofing materials, stones, rocks, drums of any size, tires, appliances, or the like will be picked up.
