22nd Run Like the Wind May 15th

The 22nd annual *Run Like the Wind* races will be held this year on **Sunday, May 15th**, in **Liberty Square** in Ellenville. The 5K run (3.1 miles) and fitness walk start at **9:30 AM**, with the 10K run (6.2 miles) starting at **9:45 AM**. The proceeds of the race will benefit the *Ellenville First-Aid and Rescue Squad*. Since the inception of the race, over \$100,000 has been raised for the *Rescue Squad*. The *Race Committee* is proud that the 10k race is a part of the 2005 Hudson Valley Grand Prix running series.

The 5K course is a relatively flat course with a few rolling hills between miles one and two. The 10K is a challenging, beautiful course. The course has an uphill start and hills follow as you run by the *Nevele Grande Hotel*, with the toughest hill at the four-mile mark on **Country Club Road**.

This year, the race will feature our area's "Best of the Hudson Valley's" winners as picked by the "Hudson Valley Magazine." *Aroma Thyme Bistro*, which won the "Best New Restaurant" category, will be donating \$25 gift certificates to the male and female winners of both the 5K and 10K runs, and will also be giving a coupon for a free dessert to all race participants. *Top Shelf Jewelry*, which won the "Best Jewelry Store" category, is donating a pin in the shape of a running shoe to the race participants. The *Shadowland Theatre*, which won the "Best Small Theatre" category, is donating a pair of season tickets to the male and female winners of the 5K and 10K runs. What a great treat for the runners and a fabulous way to showcase Ellenville! We are looking for additional items to give away to the runners. Local businesses are encouraged to donate to this great event!

Race participants will each receive a commemorative T-shirt, along with other items as a thank-you from the race committee.


Area residents are encouraged to come out and cheer the runners at any location on the course.
